- Relevant, well explained partnership
- Relevant, cross border added value in connection to regional strategies
- A unique perspective to the chosen programme priority
- Knowledge-based or innovative approach
- Sustainability of actions and results



The devil lies in the details

- Concrete outputs and results
 - > Well defined indicators
- Efficient workplan and realistic schedule
- Reasonable and realistic budget

Pro-tip: start your project preparation with the logical framework approach



Ease the workload of expert evaluation

- Readable application
 - Find a balance between the big picture and relevant details
 - Use the same logic througout the project plan
- Understandable text
 - Avoid jargon
 - Explain abbreviations and acronyms

Evaluation and selection process

- Administrative and eligibility check
 - o Programme Manual, p. 16
- Quality assessment
 - o Programme Manual, p. 18-19
 - Quality threshold 65 % (weighted final score min. 130 / max. 200)
- Joint Selection Committee recommends projects for funding
- Joint Monitoring Committee decides projects for award
